Car Parking: Due to [CycleSunday](#), Circular Road and Ladies Mile are closed until 3pm. A map showing the extent of the road closure is on the final page. Participants are therefore advised to park on Stoke Road or Saville Road and walk to assembly if arriving early. After 3pm, it is advised to park on Ladies Mile. There are no parking restrictions.

Because it is expected to be busy, it is best to park sooner, rather than trying to go as close to assembly as possible.

Assembly: Assembly is at the junction of Ladies Mile and Stoke Road. Use the pavement when walking to assembly. Under 16s must be accompanied by a responsible adult to assembly. Grid reference ST 568760, nearest post code BS9 1FG.

Map: A4 1:5000 ISSOM 2007. Based on the map 2012 map by Duncan Birtwhistle (UBOC), updated Autumn 2015 by Trevor Crowe (BOK). Overprinted with course on waterproof paper.

Terrain: Runnable grassland with a complex network of thickets, and woods with many minor paths. The courses will not visit the steep sided gorge.

Courses: String, White (1.5km), Yellow (2.1km), 45 minute Score. Helpers with 'Ask Me' bibs will assist beginners choose an appropriate course and provide advice.

On the score course there will be a manned road crossing point. Roads are not permitted to be crossed at any other point.

Registration: 14:30pm – 16:30pm. Online entry preferred at www.fabian4.co.uk by preceding Thursday. Alternatively, fill in a form on arrival. British Orienteering number required for discount. Those bringing groups of 15+ please warn the organiser two weeks in advance so that sufficient maps are printed.

Start/Closure White/Yellow/Score: 15:00pm – 17:00pm with queuing start. 500m walk to start from assembly.

Courses closes at 18:00 pm.

Entry Fee: White/Yellow: £3

Score Juniors/Students £4 Senior BOF £8.00 non-BOF £10.00.

Contactless punching will be enabled. The start and finish must be punched.
Limited number of SIAC dibbers available to hire (lost SIAC £60).
