



1. B: Work out which bush the kite should be on, then count the kites from the left at the viewing point.
2. Z: The correct bush is hidden behind another one at the viewing point.
3. A: The gap to the NE of the thicket is not easy to see, but it is there, so make sure you have the correct thicket.
