- Background:** To allow Orienteering Events to take place in a safe way for participants, helpers and the general public, and to comply with current government requirements, British Orienteering (BOF) has introduced a set of guidelines that includes a participant code of conduct; we must comply with them in both spirit & letter: [https://www.britishorienteering.org.uk/COVID19\\_Safe\\_Orienteering](https://www.britishorienteering.org.uk/COVID19_Safe_Orienteering)
- Risk Assessment:** A detailed risk assessment is being made. A flow of participants will be managed to avoid queues and interfaces with helpers to be minimised. So online results only, no EOD, etc.
- Attendance:** A local event, members of BOK and our neighbouring clubs are welcome. You should not attend if you feel unwell on the day, are the 45th President of the USA, consider yourself vulnerable or are self- isolating.
- Permissions:** At this time when permissions are difficult, we are particularly grateful to Bristol City Council as landowners for allowing us to use the Blaise Castle Estate.
- Transport:** Parking is at the main car park, nearest postcode BS10 7QU. Car park entrance what3words link: <https://w3w.co/gasp.ranged.charm> If by the time you arrive the car park is full you should park sensibly in one of the nearby roads. You must abide by the UK government's (COVID-19): safer travel guidance: <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-safer-travel-guidance-for-passengers>
- Entries:** Pre-entry only will be via F4: [www.fabian4.co.uk](http://www.fabian4.co.uk) . Please ensure that your contact details on the BOF database are up to date (*Track and Trace*). Start times will be allocated to control numbers and flow. Entry conditional on conforming to BOF guidelines (referenced above). We reserve the right to prevent participation of anyone deemed not complying with those guidelines.
- Entry Fee:** Seniors £6, Juniors & full-time students, £3 Dibber hire £1.50 (Juniors free). Lost SI (contact) cards charge £40.
- Punching:** This will be an SI mixed mode punching event, i.e. contactless punching is enabled for those who have SIACs. For contactless (SIAC) punching the start and finish must be punched.
- Map/ Terrain:** Map 1:7,500. Version TBC, 5m contours overprinted, waterproof. Parkland, and Woods.
- Courses:** Blue, Green, Short Green, Orange, Yellow. Note: Courses are provisional
- Starts/Finish** The event will be held in the morning (Starts 10.00-12.00). Courses to close by 14.00.
- Dogs:** Well behaved dogs and their owners are welcome. This is a municipal park so there will be other members of the public and in some cases they will have dogs with them so we need to be respectful of their use of the park but also to be aware that, sadly, not all dog owners are as thoughtful as we would wish them to be.
